



Women's Transportation Seminar

The Greater Dallas/Fort Worth Chapter of WTS is accepting applications for four scholarships for graduate and undergraduate students interested in the transportation field:

The **Wanda J. Schafer Graduate Scholarship** encourages women to pursue career paths in transportation. This \$1,500 scholarship is awarded to students pursuing graduate studies in transportation or a related field.

The **Dallas/Fort Worth Chapter WTS Undergraduate Scholarship** fosters the development of women in the transportation field by encouraging bright new professionals to undertake careers in transportation. This award is for \$1,000.

The **Monique Pegues Undergraduate Leadership Scholarship** motivates and rewards women who demonstrate leadership in the transportation industry. This is a \$1,000 scholarship.

The **President's Legacy Scholarship***

Minimum criteria for selection are as follows:

- Open to women only
- GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Currently enrolled in a degree program in a transportation-related field, such as transportation engineering, planning, finance, logistics, etc. in portions of Texas and Oklahoma (see application for specific eligible schools)
- Plans to pursue a career in a transportation-related field (past applicants have had backgrounds in urban planning, public policy, public safety, emergency response, and civil, mechanical, electrical, and environmental engineering)

*There is no local award for the President's Legacy Scholarship – a nominee will compete for an international award. All local winners are nominated for WTS international scholarships.

The application form and accompanying transcript, personal statement, and letter(s) of recommendation must be submitted with post mark no later than October 28, 2011.
