Instructions: For each statement under "Evaluation Criteria", rate the applicant from 1 (average) to 5 (truly exceptional) by circling the number. Total the scores and place the value on the line labeled "Total".

Notes: Please reserve a score of 5 for an application that is truly exceptional. If all parts of all applications are great, then none are the "exception" (and therefore none are "truly exceptional") – you would instead rank them as "outstanding". However, try to use a wide range of numbers in your scoring.

If after you have tallied all applicants' scores you have two applicants with the *same* score, make a decision which application you like better and add 1 point to its score. If this creates another like-score, continue in this method until all of your scores are distinct. Put your new, final score in the box labeled "Final Score".
