1. OVERALL PROJECT SUMMARY:

The project summary clearly describes: (check all that apply)

- what the student will do
- how the student will do it
- what the student expects to find
- why it will be important

2. PROJECT ORIGINALITY & CREATIVITY:

The proposal clearly describes how the project: (check all that apply)

- differs from others in the field
- has a distinctive focus
- has not been previously done
- is a novel advancement

3. PROJECT GOALS & PURPOSES:

The proposal clearly describes: (check all that apply)

- what the project will accomplish
- reasonable goals
- aims of the investigation
- a persuasive rationale for the project

4. PROJECT METHODS, PROCESSES & PROCEDURES:

The proposal clearly describes: (check all that apply)

- the methods or procedures
- a justification for the processes
- research materials
- how analysis will be done

5. PROJECT CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE FIELD/COMMUNITY:

The proposal clearly describes: (check all that apply)

- how the project advances knowledge
- the project benefits
- the long-term impact
- the relevance for broader audiences

6. PROJECT PREVIOUS RESEARCH/ LITERATURE REVIEW:

The proposal clearly: (check all that apply)

- shares what is currently known
- relates the project to current research
- uses the lit review to support rationale
- cites sources

7. PROJECT TIMELINE:

The proposal clearly describes: (check all that apply)

- the time periods allocated for work
- the duties associated with time intervals
- a realistic plan for work
- evidence of high probability for completion

8. PROJECT BUDGET:

The proposal clearly: (check all that apply)

- describes expenses
- justifies expenses
- includes expenses relevant to the project's completion
- offers a total amount within RCSA grant parameters

9. PROPOSAL COHERENCE:

The proposal: (check all that apply)

- clearly communicates concepts
- is written for a general audience
- thoroughly addresses topics
- is convincing and engaging

10. PROPOSAL GRAMMAR, MECHANICS & SYNTAX:

The proposal writing: (check all that apply)

- lacks typographical errors
- adheres to scholarly writing style
- uses appropriate sentence structure
- has strong grammar and mechanics
