Visit www.fafsa.gov and complete your Free Application for Federal Student Aid by February 3, 2020 for scholarship consideration. All students are required to complete the FAFSA to be considered for institutional scholarships.
- 4 DIVERSIFY YOUR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS**

Visit www.uco.edu/scholarship to view other university scholarship opportunities. In addition, research 3rd party scholarships to help pay for school.

Scholarship committees will begin reviewing applications in February and scholarship notifications will be sent by email by April 2020.

Broncho Advantage	\$4,000 per year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Broncho Advantage States: Arizona, Arkansas, California, Iowa, Kansas, Mississippi, New Mexico, Texas • Graduate from a high school in Broncho Advantage State or Home School Students must show a permanent address in a Broncho Advantage State. • Meet university admission requirements. 	4 years

*Tuition is applied automatically to qualifying students. No application necessary. Additional documents may be required to determine eligibility for the program. Broncho Advantage awards are mutually exclusive and students are limited to one Broncho Advantage award even when they may qualify for multiple discounts.

UCO AUTOMATIC ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS*

Academic Scholarships are awarded based upon a point total using the following formula:

$$\text{(High School GPA X 25) + (ACT Composite Score X 2.78)*}$$

*SAT scores are accepted for scholarship consideration and are converted to an ACT score for awarding purposes.

Example: (3.6 GPA X 25) + (26 Composite ACT X 2.78)

Point Total: **90 + 72.28 = 162.28**
