

UCO Kinesiology – Exercise/Fitness Management Program Data

Majors in the Kinesiology Exercise/Fitness Management program are accredited by the Committee on Accreditation for the Exercise Sciences, part of the Commission Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs. This accreditation is renewed every year. The accreditation process helps ensure students receive an educational experience based on the standards of the field.

As part of the accreditation, the department must collect data regarding student performance and satisfaction of the program, as well as information from faculty, alumni, and employers. Current data can be seen below:

Employment and Graduate School

Students enrolled in graduate school or employed within one year of graduation:

2018: 80%

Employer Satisfaction Survey

Employers and graduate faculty of alumni students are surveyed one year following the student's graduation date. Employer satisfaction rates:

2018: 88%

Graduate Satisfaction Survey

Graduating students of the exercise/fitness program complete a survey regarding faculty, practical experience, and academic coursework. Student graduate satisfaction rates:

2018: 85%

2017: 95%

Culminating Experience

Students are evaluated on their internship performance by faculty supervisors. Scores of exceptional (86-100%), and sufficient (70-85%). Students scoring sufficient or above:

2018: 100%
