

The ACT or SAT may be used to replace the Oklahoma General Education Test (OGET) if the proper documentation is received by the Teacher Education Services office. (TES) This will save you both time and money.

Your ACT score *must* include the <u>writing portion</u> and have a minimum composite score of 22. The SAT composite score must be a minimum of 1120 AND you must score 5 or higher on reading, 4 or higher on analysis, and 5 or higher on writing.

The Office of Educational Quality and Accountability (OEQA) will accept these scores in the following manner:

- > Copy of an official ACT or SAT score or
- Screenshot of your scores which must include your full name, the composite score and include the writing portion if the ACT is submitted or
- A screenshot of your test scores in UCO's Banner platform provided to TES from your academic advisor.
- > High school transcripts listing ACT with Writing scores are not an acceptable form of submission to the OEQA.

The ACT or SAT scores must be submitted to <u>TESOffice@uco.edu</u>. Once the TES office receives them, we will send you a "Request for ACT/SAT Review" form which you will complete and return to <u>TESOffice@uco.edu</u>. The TES Office will then submit the request form and ACT or SAT scores to OEQA for approval.

The TES Office will notify you if OEQA has approved the OGET waiver and admit you into the teacher education program if you meet all of the other requirements for admission.
